The emblematic village of Cadaqués, the birthplace of great artists like Salvador Dalí, is the new destination for wecamp. Nestled between the sea and mountains of this former fishing village, wecamp Cadaqués is located in an enclave that invites you to explore its pristine beaches and vibrant trails. Among its endless natural corners, the cove of Portlligat has been chosen as wecamp's location. The new campsite aims to emphasize the connection with nature, offering a vacation atmosphere of relaxation and rest.

wecamp Cadaqués promotes a clear predominance of nature, with a cohesive use of noble materials to create a relaxed and natural environment. It maintains the aesthetics of Cadaqués, featuring characteristic white buildings with elements of wood and ceramics.

Through spacious, bright, and functional finishes highlighting noble materials and artisanal details, the interior design project led by Sandra Tarruella's studio has managed to give the new campsite a personality with clear architectural and aesthetic references to the 1960s. This period was characterized by designs that emphasized simplicity and austerity, with abundant use of natural materials like ceramic tiles and slate walls.



THE AUTHENTIC AESTHETIC OF THE COSTA BRAVA

wecamp represents the 1960s style of the Costa Brava with its white facades and red roofs. It's a place where simplicity harmonizes with design and comfort. The accommodations include apartments, glamping tents, tiny homes, and exclusive pitches for motorhomes, all ensuring the comfort of a hotel with queen-size beds, amenities, sheets, and towels.

wecamp offers accommodations that blend minimally with the environment, respecting nature and the community while providing the comfort standards of a hotel.

A new destination whose versatile proposal of accommodations gives prominence to the outdoor environment without losing attention to the interior details, which emphasize the local tradition of Alt Empordà.

Versatile and open spaces with a minimalist style, designed for interaction between people. Noble materials of Mediterranean style, such as ceramics, terracotta tiles, and warm-toned wood, reflecting the original style of Alt Empordà.

Moreover, as an added value to its vacation offering, wecamp Cadaqués provides numerous modern architecture common areas, creating a contemporary and functional atmosphere.



EL TRASTOCAT

The new restaurant at wecamp Cadaqués is located in the heart of the resort, next to the pool and a terrace with breathtaking views.

El Trastocat offers a casual, summery, and high-quality menu, featuring Andalusian-style calamari with kimchi mayonnaise, seasonal tomato salad with stracciatella, Red Prawn Ravioli, 30-day-aged Galician Blonde Ribeye, and their signature artisanal pizzas like truffle, egg, and fontina. It also offers a take-away service to enjoy the gastronomic offerings in your own accommodation.

The restaurant is decorated mainly with wooden and natural materials, like rattan, with a touch of vibrant color in the furnishings and distinctive lighting, including iconic design pieces. The terrace, surrounded by olive trees and designed as a seamless continuation of the interior in both materials and furnishings, provides a perfect outdoor space for snacks, cocktails, and summer dinners. Its subtle and ambient lighting, accompanied by live music in late summer evenings, has turned El Trastocat into the hot spot of Cadaqués.



STAY IN A NEW EXPERIENCE

5 Glamping couple.

The redesigned and improved camping tent for two offers a connection to the surrounding nature and a sense of well-being. Equipped with a private bathroom, coffee maker, fridge, terrace, and outdoor furniture, it is perfect for couples.

5 Glamping Comfort.

This accommodation for four people combines spaciousness and versatility to make you feel at home. The tent is equipped with a kitchen, private bathroom, closets, terrace, and outdoor furniture.

3 Glamping Family +.

With a capacity for six people, this option is ideal for group or family stays. The spacious and comfortable tent includes a mezzanine level. It features a kitchen, private bathroom, closets, terrace, and outdoor furniture.

15 Cottage Couple family.

Designed for two or four guests, these lodges offer a simple and contemporary way to connect with the surrounding nature. Small lodge-style tents with a terrace, sofa, and outdoor furniture are set in the shade of olive trees. They are equipped with the essentials for a glamping experience, such as a closet, office space, coffee maker, fridge, utensils, and a fan.

20 Tiny Homes.



These accommodations for four people bring back the feeling of freedom as they merge with the essential natural surroundings. Smartly designed, they leave a minimal ecological footprint. These small white wooden houses feature a terrace and outdoor furniture in wood and fabric. They are laid out over two levels, with two double bedrooms, a kitchen, an indoor sofa, and a private bathroom. Perfect for family or friend stays, the friendly neighborhood of tiny homes resembles the white streets of Cadaqués.

8 Apartamentos.

With a maritime style and wooden finishing, these apartments represent the architectural tradition of emblematic Cadaqués. They offer homes for two (Couple Apartments), three (Couple + Apartments), or five people (Family + Apartments) and provide all the comforts to fully experience the local life of the place you are visiting. Some apartments include a built-in living room that can convert into an additional single bed, as well as a dining area. The wooden volume houses a small office-style kitchen, storage, and the apartment's private bathroom.

73 Parcelas.

These parcels are the option for those traveling with caravans, campervans, or camper vans. They offer a level, stable, and tranquil space with access to all services and common areas, overlooking the Cap de Creus Natural Park.



MAXIMUM RESPONSIBILITY, MINIMAL ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT

Investing in eco-friendly technology, promoting sustainable experiences, encouraging responsible consumption, recognizing diversity, and supporting local producers are some of the activities aligned with the United Nations' 2030 Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).

At wecamp, the motto “as green as possible” applies to all infrastructure, designed by experts in energy efficiency. The goal is to utilize local resources, minimize the carbon footprint, and use locally sourced materials.

Renewable energy sources, including aerothermal systems, power a significant portion of the facilities, including the common areas. LED bulbs are used for lighting throughout the camping site to reduce energy consumption. Rainwater harvesting systems are implemented for irrigation, and water-saving elements like low-consumption toilets and water-saving devices are installed.

The wecamp landscaping project focuses on protecting biodiversity by planting 17,506 new plant species. As part of their commitment to sustainable mobility, wecamp provides a fleet of electric buggies and an exclusive charging station for them. y una estación de carga exclusiva para ellos.

Designed for your well-being, wecamp offers a **Local Guide** in its app, providing countless non-mass tourism and sustainable plans that bring you closer to the lifestyle, natural environment, history, and culture of Cadaqués.

Explore routes to discover modernist houses, historic Indiano buildings, or the Rastell area, all of which are part of the **old town** of Cadaqués.

Additionally, wecamp organizes activities such as boat excursions to Far dels Nans or trips on “llaüts” (traditional fishing boats) to explore the most emblematic coves of the Cap de Creus Natural Park, allowing you to deeply immerse yourself in marine life. You can also prepare a picnic or **engage in sports** like kayaking or hiking, enjoying the rugged landscape of Alt Empordà, which can be booked through wecamp. These outdoor activities offer an immersion in the natural surroundings, contributing to your well-being.

Cadaqués boasts a rich history and a vibrant artistic and cultural scene, making it worth visiting the iconic Salvador Dalí House-Museum. The small fisherman’s house in Portlligat was where Salvador Dalí lived and worked from 1930 until the death of his wife Gala in 1982, after which he moved to the Castle of Púbol.

Finally, **gastronomic tastings** of seasonal products or local wine tastings in this landscape of sea and mountains, surrounded by olive trees and vineyards, offer unique culinary experiences.
