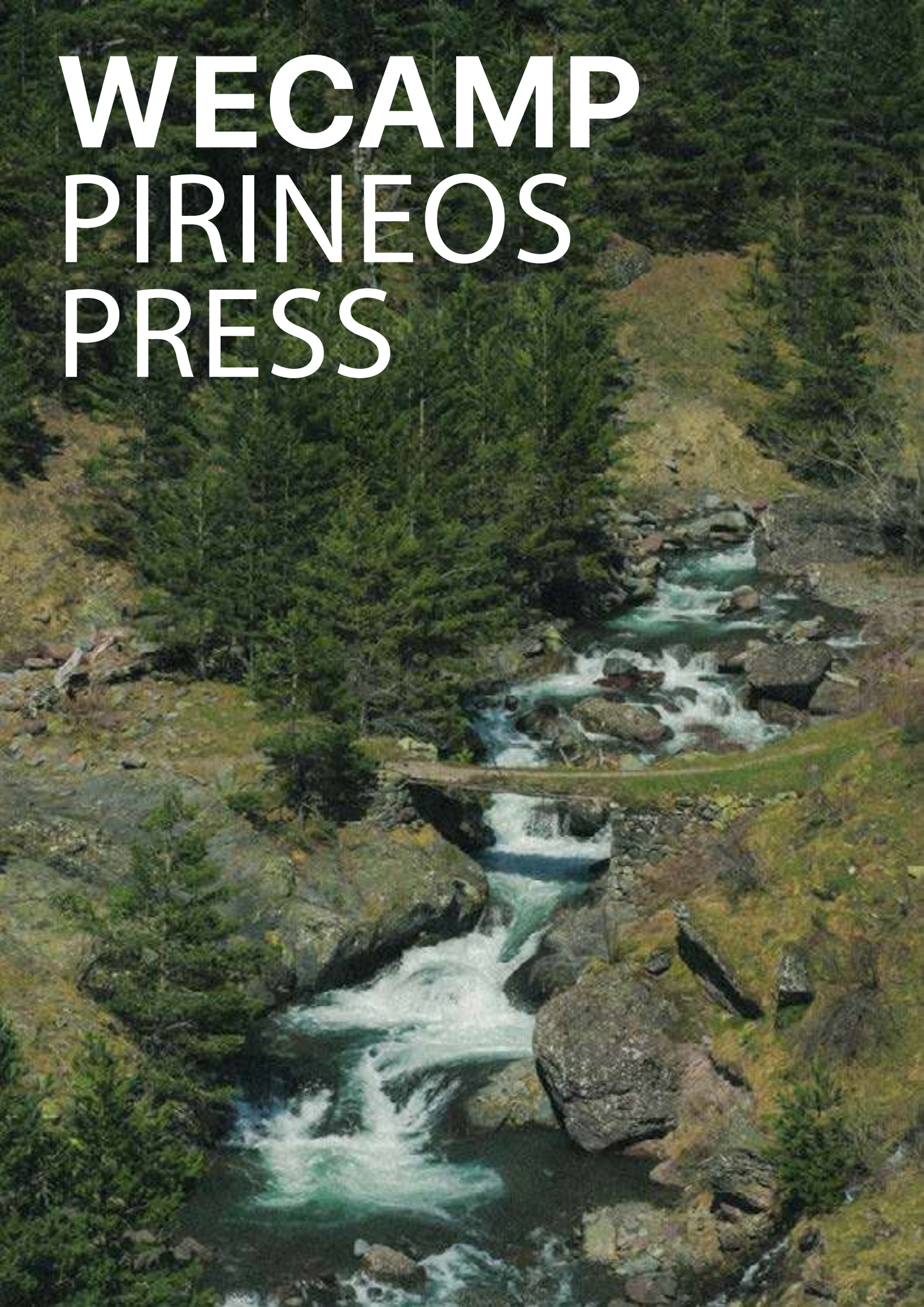

PURE NATURE IN THE ARAGONESE PYRENEES

Boltaña, located near the Sierra and Canyons of Guara, Ordesa and Monte Perdido, two emblematic natural parks, is the mountainous territory through which to connect with the nature and culture of the Pyrenees.

Boltaña is the enclave that combines natural beauty, cultural heritage, festivities, and traditions in the Sobrarbe region. To get to know this high mountain region is to discover its **natural reserves**: canyons, caves, ravines, and peaks that represent the authentic Boltaña experience. In addition to its **historic center**, which hides a huge centenary castle, several churches, and old stone houses.

A town full of life that invites you to perform activities such as hiking, climbing, or canyoning. In addition, the river **Ésera** draws a landscape of crystalline waters that will allow you to practice water sports such as rafting or fishing.

For this, wecamp has chosen these abrupt lands surrounded by forests and meadows as a destination to open its doors.



ACCOMMODATIONS THAT BLEND WITH THE SCENIC REALITY OF EACH ENCLAVE

All accommodations include a microwave, refrigerator, crockery, towels, sheets, and ventilation system.

7 Bell Tent y Bell Tent +.

The safari-style tent, for two or three people, stands out for its luminosity, height, ventilation, and permeability. Its infrastructure includes a wooded platform to enjoy as a terrace, and its interior houses a spacious and versatile environment.

8 Bengalí.

The most authentic camping experience for families or large groups. It can accommodate up to 5 people, with a distribution of 1 double bed and 3 single beds. It has a kitchen, terrace, and dining room.

4 Bungalow Basic Couple.

A wooden house for two people, offering an experience where comfort is not incompatible with adventure. An accommodation where you can experience silence, design, and privacy. The Bungalows have a kitchen and private bathroom.

19 Bungalow Basic Family.

The stay for four people, organized with two double beds, offers the comforts of a home. Fully equipped and air-conditioned. The Bungalows have a kitchen and private bathroom.

10 Mobile Home Basic Family XL.

The mobile home, for six people, combines private rooms and common areas for a comfortable and functional stay. It is distributed in a master bedroom with a double bed, another bedroom with two beds, and a sofa that converts into a bed.



19 Mobile Home Family.

For four people, it is a compact and efficient space consisting of a master bedroom with a double bed and two single beds. The accommodation has a main living room that leads to the private terrace, acting as an extension of the sleeping area. It has a fully equipped kitchen and private bathroom.

3 Mobile Home Couple Plus.

For three people, it is a spacious and cozy accommodation organized with a main double room and a sofa bed. Its cozy terrace with an outdoor sofa allows you to enjoy your outdoor getaways. It has a fully equipped kitchen and private bathroom.

182 Parcelas.

The plots, available in different sizes, are the option for those traveling with a caravan, van, or tent. These conditioned spaces include the use of barbecue as a recreational area. We provide services for these accommodations, such as Camper Clean, toilets with sinks, laundry, electricity, and water.

COMMON AREAS FOR A MOUNTAIN CAMPSITE

wecamp offers a set of common areas designed to immerse you in the local culture of the place you are visiting. At the same time, it encourages and promotes interaction with the environment and other guests.

Located in the heart of the campsite, the **restaurant** brings traditional and local recipes to all its visitors through seasonal and local ingredients. The restaurant is housed in a glass structure that allows natural light to fill the interior and its spaciousness permits group dinners and events. Additionally, there is a bar, located in a stone building, offering a year-round enjoyment.

Between meadows and mountains, the swimming pool area rests under the native vegetation of Boltaña. It is divided into a **children's area**, with recreational facilities such as slides and water outlets, and a **solarium**, a green area equipped with sun loungers and parasols for summer vacations.

Moreover, the **Kids Club** offers playful activities for the little ones in the house.

Each area has a common thread of using **natural materials and organic textures** in the rustic and traditional style of the area, such as stone walls, ceilings with wooden beams, and terracotta tile floors, which provide **warmth and authenticity**.

wecamp Pirineos has a sports area where you can practice paddle tennis, football, basketball, and skateboarding.

WE CARE, WE CAMP

Investing in eco-friendly technology, promoting sustainable experiences, encouraging responsible consumption, recognizing diversity, and supporting local producers are some of the tasks aligned with the UN's 2030 Sustainable Development Goals, which wecamp embraces as its own.

Under the motto 'As green as possible,' wecamp is a green construction that relies on **renewable energy and eco-friendly technology**, generating 60.56% of the total camping light. Additionally, monthly studies and controls managed by energy efficiency experts aim to be more responsible and efficient with the set of energy resources. To enhance **lighting efficiency**, low-consumption LED lighting elements are installed to avoid light pollution.

Furthermore, the entire team of professionals at wecamp is trained and conscious about proper resource management and evaluation. **The goal is to minimize food waste and single-use plastic usage.**

Various **water-saving systems** are implemented, including the use of single-handle faucets, dual flush cisterns, and the promotion of native plants that don't require irrigation. Adequate treatment of wastewater and graywater is ensured, and recycling points are available throughout the camping site.

The landscaping project implemented by wecamp involves the installation of 995 plant species, including 930 shrubs and 65 trees.

LOCAL EXPERIENCES

Surrounded by rivers, mountains, trails, and forests, the Local Guide from wecamp Pirineos emphasizes its adventure sports proposition through a set of experiences that blend nature and sports. All of these experiences are available on their own app, allowing visitors to enjoy a pure and local

HIKING ROUTES IN THE NATURAL PARK OF AINSA

The Aragonese Pyrenees stand out for their unique landscape, offering green scenery in summer and white landscapes in winter. **Aínsa region**, with its canyons, waterfalls, pools, rivers, rock formations, and rich flora and fauna, is an exceptional location for **hiking**. Moreover, it is close to other natural parks like **Ordesa and Monte Perdido National Park**.

HORSEBACK RIDING

Horseback hiking is a way to venture into remote areas away from civilization, immersing in nature, history, and culture. It fosters values like companionship with the horse and a sense of adventure while engaging in this intense sport.

VISIT TO SOMONTANO WINERIES

Discover a new landscape, history, and culture through an unforgettable visit to the vineyards of Somontano. This region produces some of the best wines in Spain and boasts some of the most beautiful villages in the country. Enjoy wine tastings of its fifteen different grape varieties in more than thirty wineries.

CANYONING

Using ropes to descend, mostly through aquatic canyons, though there are also some dry ones, canyoning can be tailored to cater to family fun, especially for the younger ones, with jumps and slides.

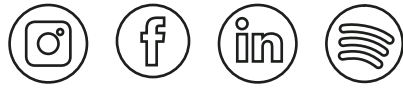
