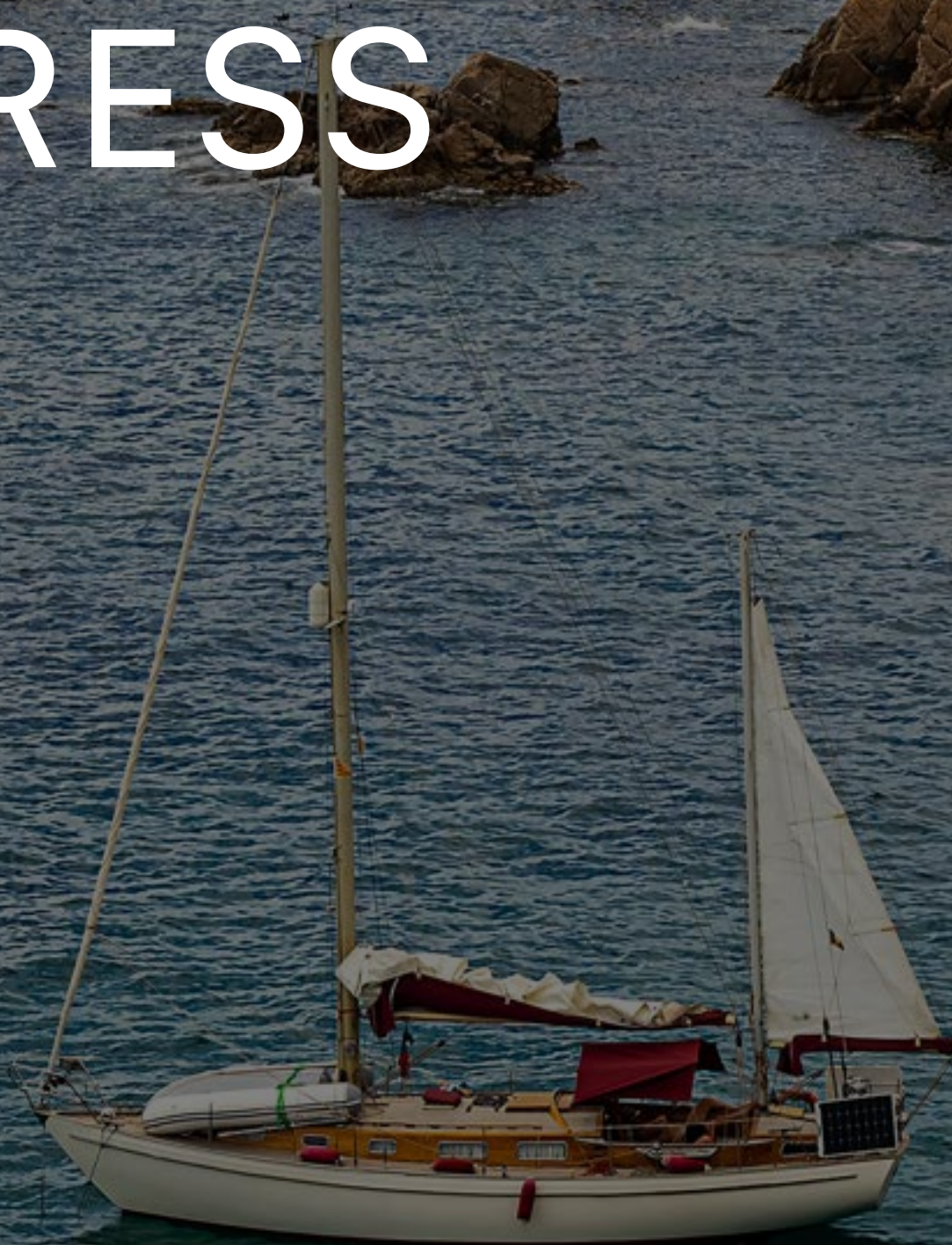

The emblematic village of Cadaqués, cradle of great artists such as Salvador Dalí, is the new wecamp destination. Between the sea and the mountains of this old fishing village, wecamp Cadaqués is located in an enclave that invites you to stroll along its unspoilt beaches and lively paths. Among its infinite natural corners, the cove of Portlligat is the place chosen by wecamp. The new campsite seeks to emphasise the relationship with nature with a holiday aesthetic in an atmosphere of relaxation and rest.

wecamp Cadaqués claims a clear predominance of nature where the common thread is the use of noble materials to create a relaxed and natural atmosphere. It also maintains the aesthetics of the village of Cadaqués, a very characteristic image with white buildings, wooden and ceramic elements.

Through spacious, luminous and functional finishes that stand out for the use of noble materials and details full of craftsmanship, this interior design project carried out by Sandra Tarruella's studio has managed to give personality to the new campsite with a clear architectural and aesthetic reference to the 1960s. An era where the greats of design designed various works in which austerity and simplicity were the strong point. Projects where there was an abundance of masonry elements, white walls and local natural materials, as well as ceramic tiles and slate walls.



THE AUTHENTIC AESTHETICS OF THE COSTA BRAVA

wecamp is the campsite with white facades and red roofs, which represents the style of the sixties on the Costa Brava. A place where simplicity is not at odds with design and comfort.

Flats, glamping tents, tiny homes and exclusive pitches for motorhomes, wecamp guarantees the comfort of a hotel with queen size beds, amenities, sheets and towels.

A new destination whose versatile accommodation

wecamp presents a proposal for accommodation with minimal intervention with the environment, where respect for nature and the community is in tune with the comfort standards of a hotel.

proposal gives prominence to the outdoor environment without losing attention to the interior details, which claim the local tradition of the Alt Empordà.

Versatile, open-plan spaces, minimalist in style, designed for interaction between people. Noble Mediterranean-style materials, such as ceramics, terracotta tiles and wood in warm tones typical of the original Alt Empordà style.

Furthermore, as an added value to its holiday proposal, wecamp Cadaqués has numerous common areas, with modern architecture, which create a contemporary and functional atmosphere.



EL TRASTOCAT

The new restaurant of wecamp Cadaqués is located in the nerve centre of the complex next to the swimming pool and a terrace where the views are the protagonists.

El Trastocat offers a casual, summery and quality menu: Andalusian style squid with kimchi mayonnaise, Seasonal tomato salad with stracciatella, Red Prawn Ravioli, Galician blonde steak 30 days matured or its signature Pizzas such as truffle, egg and fontina. It also offers take away service to enjoy the gastronomic offer in your own accommodation.

The restaurant is mainly dressed with wooden furniture and natural materials such as rattan, but with a touch of cauldron colour thanks to the gueridones and a touch of distinction in the lighting with some iconic pieces of design; the terrace area, among large olive trees and understood as a continuation of the interior, both in materials and furniture. An outdoor area perfect for snacks, cocktails and summer dinners. Its dim and ambient lighting, enlivened by live music at the end of the summer, has turned Trastocat into the spot of Cadaqués.



STAY IN A NEW EXPERIENCE

5 Glamping couple.

The camping tent, for two people, redesigned and improved to connect with the well-being offered by the surrounding nature. With private bathroom, coffee maker, fridge, terrace and outdoor furniture. Perfect for your outings as a couple.

5 Glamping Comfort.

A room for four people whose spaciousness and versatility will connect you with the feeling of home. A tent equipped with kitchen, private bathroom, wardrobes, terrace and outdoor furniture.

3 Glamping Family +.

With a capacity for six people, it is the ideal alternative for a group or family stay. A spacious and comfortable tent offering an infrastructure equipped with a mezzanine. A tent equipped with kitchen, private bathroom, cupboards, terrace and outdoor furniture.

15 Cottage Couple family.

For two or four guests a tent to get close to nature in a simple and contemporary way. Small lodge tents with terrace, sofa and outdoor furniture to enjoy in the shade of the olive trees. Equipped with just what you need for a glamping experience. With wardrobe, office, coffee maker, fridge, kitchen utensils and fan.

20 Tiny Homes.

The Tiny homes, for 4 people, will give you back the feeling of freedom by merging you with the essential: the natural environment. An intelligent construction for a unique experience with the smallest possible ecological footprint. Tiny houses made of white wooden slats, with a terrace and outdoor furniture in wood and fabric. An optimised two-level layout with two double bedrooms, kitchen, interior sofa and private bathroom. Perfect for stays with family or friends. The friendly tinys neighbourhood is reminiscent of the white streets of Cadaqués.

8 Apartments.

With a seafaring style and wood finish, they represent the architectural tradition of the emblematic Cadaqués. A home for two (Couple Apartments), three (Couple + Apartments) or five people (Family + Apartments) with all the comforts to make the most of the local experience of belonging to the place you are visiting. Some flats include a living room with a sofa that can be converted into an auxiliary single bed and a dining room, while in the wooden volume there is a small kitchenette next to the dining room, storage and the a private bathroom.

73 Plots.

The plots are the option for those who move around in a caravan, motor home or camper van. A flat, stable and quiet space with accessibility to all services and common areas with views of the Natural Park of Cap de Creus.



MAXIMUM RESPONSIBILITY, MINIMUM ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT

Investing in eco-technology, promoting sustainable experiences, generating responsible consumption, recognising diversity and supporting local producers are some of the tasks that are aligned with the SDG 2030 (Sustainable Development Goals) promoted by the United Nations.

Under the motto '**as green as possible**' at wecamp, all infrastructure is green construction designed by **energy efficiency** experts, whose objectives are to take advantage of local resources, minimise the carbon footprint and use local materials. In addition to implementing the **use of renewable energies** in a large part of its facilities, including the common services, which are powered by aerothermal systems.

On the other hand, the lighting system of the campsite works with LED bulbs to **reduce energy consumption**. A system has been set up to use rainwater for irrigation and water-saving elements have been installed, such as low-consumption toilets or aerator filterer at terminal points.

wecamp's landscaping project is based on protecting the biodiversity of the habitat with the installation of 17,506 newly planted plant species. Finally, as part of its commitment to sustainable mobility, it has a fleet of electric buggies and a charging station exclusively for them.

LOCAL EXPERIENCES THAT CONNECT YOU TO THE DESTINATION

Designed for your wellbeing, wecamp's Local Guide App includes a host of uncrowded and sustainable plans that will bring you closer to the lifestyle, natural environment, history and culture of Cadaqués.

Routes to discover the modernist houses, the historic Indian buildings or the Rastell area are just some of the things to do in the old quarter of Cadaqués.

On the other hand, wecamp offers organised activities, such as boat trips to the Far dels Nans or Ilaüt trips to the most emblematic coves of the Cap de Creus Natural Park are some of the nautical activities that will allow you to get to know the marine life in depth. In addition, preparing a picnic or **practising sports** such as kayaking or hiking are some of the alternatives offered by the rugged landscape of the Alt Empordà, which can be booked through wecamp. A set of outdoor activities that represent an immersion in the natural environment, for an experience that has a direct impact on our wellbeing.

Cadaqués has a rich history and a vibrant arts and culture scene, making the iconic Salvador Dalí House Museum well worth a visit. The small fisherman's house in Portlligat, where Salvador Dalí lived and worked from 1930 until the death of his wife Gala in 1982, when he decided to move to Púbol Castle.

Finally, seasonal gastronomic tastings or local wine tastings, in this landscape of sea and mountains surrounded by olive trees and vineyards.
