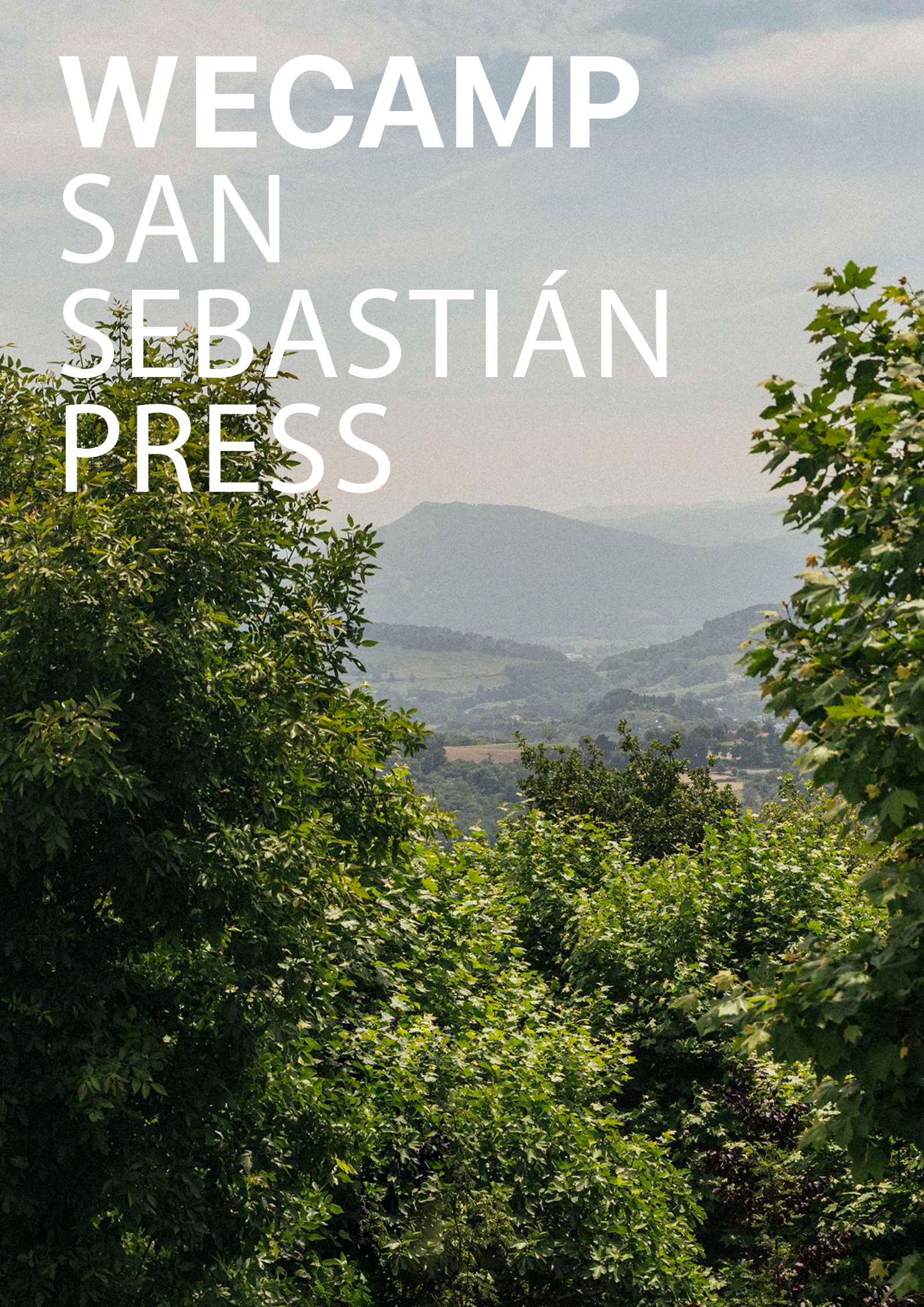

SAN SEBASTIAN IN A BEAUTIFUL SETTING BETWEEN THE MOUNTAINS AND THE SEA

San Sebastian, the town bathed by the emblematic Concha Beach, is an extraordinary city surrounded by wild hills leading to true natural oases.

Among them, Mount Igueldo, rising over two hundred meters above sea level, is the path chosen by wecamp for a new generation of eco-friendly campsites, meeting the quality and comfort standards of a hotel.

Also known as Donostia, this town blends green landscapes with the blue of the sea, offering visitors a spectacular gastronomic, cultural, and sports experience.

Nestled in Mount Igueldo, just 5km from the historic center of San Sebastian, is the location of the new wecamp camping site. This space is enveloped by wild hills, and its infrastructure is based on respect for biodiversity and the use of renewable energies. wecamp San Sebastian is the first city establishment that allows you to experience a natural oasis on the mountaintop.

Descending to the city, you'll find the picturesque promenade along the bay and its world-renowned restaurants led by innovative chefs. In the cobbled Old Part, luxury shops coexist with bars offering bite-sized local pinchos and regional specialties.



COMMON AREAS DESIGNED FOR THOSE SEEKING MORE THAN JUST A CAMPING EXPERIENCE

The common areas, with environmentally-friendly and coherent infrastructure, have been designed for those looking for a comprehensive stay that combines well-being with a local experience.

Among them, the **restaurant** is the gastronomic space offering a selection of authentic dishes, where seafood and mountain recipes come together to create a unique zero-kilometer experience.

The **Bar** is the area housing a terrace with valley views for outdoor enjoyment, as well as a covered space for year-round relaxation. Nestled between the mountains and the sea, the swimming pool rests under the native vegetation of the Cantabrian region.

It provides a **swimming area** with wooden flooring transitioning to a solarium, catering to the enjoyment of families and those seeking a customized holiday.

To enhance the gastronomic experience in the area, wecamp offers a picnic area with a picnic site, water fountain, and barbecue facilities. This space is specially designed for glamping tents and authentic travelers exploring with campervans.



With a focus on the United Nations' 2030 **Sustainable Development Goals**, wecamp aims to contribute to the planet in a responsible and respectful manner. To achieve this, the camping site promotes green and energy-efficient buildings and actively collaborates in the protection and restoration of native flora and fauna. This has been made possible **through the expertise of energy efficiency** specialists who have worked to optimize the use of local resources, minimize the carbon footprint, and create an enjoyable and versatile environment.

Moreover, the motto **"As green as possible"** is strengthened by the use of renewable energies in many of its facilities, powered by aerothermal systems supported by solar panels. Solar photovoltaic equipment is also available in some accommodations (such as Mobilhomes), and recycling points are placed throughout the camping site. Investing in eco-technology, promoting sustainable experiences, encouraging responsible consumption, recognizing diversity, and supporting local producers are some of the tasks carried out by wecamp.

As part of this commitment, the camping site has implemented a selective recycling system throughout the area, along with a scalable and adaptable energy efficiency program.

Additionally, the camping site's lighting system uses LED bulbs to reduce energy consumption. Rainwater harvesting systems have been established for irrigation and other water-saving elements, such as low-consumption toilets and water-saving aerators.

The minimum intervention is demonstrated in wecamp's landscaping project, protecting habitat biodiversity with the installation of 2057 plant species.

Finally, as part of its commitment to sustainable mobility, the camping site provides a fleet of electric buggies and an exclusive charging station for them.

A stroll through the city allows visitors to admire the works of **Eduardo Chillida and Jorge Oteiza**, which integrate seamlessly into the cityscape and engage in dialogue with the surrounding nature. Some must-visit places for delving into the local culture include the San Telmo Museum, the Basilica of Santa Maria del Coro, and the Koldo Mitxelena Cultural Center.

ESCAPE TO FRENCH BASQUE COUNTRY

The cities and towns of **French Basque Country** complement your escape. The most emblematic ones, such as Hondarribia, Getaria, Zarautz, Zumaia, and Mutriku, are known for their historical heritage, chapels, and monuments.

THE MECCA OF SURFING

Surfing is a highlight in Donostia. Surfers from around the world gather at **Zurriola** Beach, the perfect spot for catching waves and enjoying a youthful atmosphere. For a more serene ambiance, **Ondarreta** Beach is also one of Spain’s best locations for practicing this sport.
